<p>Collection description:</p> <p>This manuscript volume of Indian vocabulary by Albert Gallatin (1761-1849), financier, diplomat, statesman, and ethnologist, represents part of Gallatin's work, <u>A Synopsis of the Indian Tribes of North America</u>, published by the American Antiquarian Society in 1836. The volume, evidently a printer's copy, compares the vocabulary of many North American Indian tribes and also contains select sentences from various tribal languages.</p> <p>There are also two letters by Gallatin dated 1826 and 1846 respectively, the earlier one pertaining to Indian languages.</p>
