**Collection description:**

Alonzo Andrews (1815-1897) and Richard Ward (1819-1898) formed a partnership in 1842 and opened a retail provision store at 9 Bromfield Street in Boston, Mass. Ward retired from the business in about five years and Andrews continued alone, in various locations in Boston, until his death.

This volume is a daybook of Andrews and Ward grocery business, 1842 to 1844. The book includes accounts for Rufus Choate, Abbott Lawrence, Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, Josiah Quincy, and George Ticknor.
