Collection description:

The Ascutney Mill Dam Company was located in Windsor, Windsor Co., Vt. The president of the company was Jonathan Hatch Hubbard (1768-1849), a lawyer. He was born in Tolland, Conn., on 7 May 1768, received an honorary degree from Dartmouth College in 1813, and was judge of the supreme court of Vermont for the years 1813 to 1815. Hubbard died at Windsor on 22 September 1849.

This small collection of business papers of the Ascutney Mill Dam Company contains notes and deeds for the year 1836 for six men: Austin Burns, Joseph S. Commings, Charles H. Cotton, Joseph D. Hatch, William W. Leverett, and Apollos Munn. The notes, dated during the period 16 April to 18 May 1836, were all ordered to be paid on 9 November 1841. Five of the deeds were dated 2 May 1836, the last was dated 19 May 1836.

The collection also contains a report dated, 29 December 1858, from H. W. Adams.
