COLLECTION DESCRIPTION:

Athol, Worcester County, Massachusetts is located on Miller's River, forty-eight miles north-northwest of Springfield, Mass., and thirty-three miles west of Fitchburg, Mass. It was settled in 1735 and incorporated in 1762.

This collection of town records of Athol, Mass., includes some two hundred ninety-seven receipts of valuation of local properties in 1814 and 1815. There are two sequences of valuations and each is arranged alphabetically by property holder.

There is an eight-page transcript of the early records of the Congregational Church gathered at Perguage (Athol) in 1750. It contains a list of the founding members, as well as the names of persons who joined the church after that date and through 1828.

There are two volumes containing gravestone information. One volume contains epitaphs for the period 1773 to 1830. The other volume, entitled "Athol Burial Grounds," covers the period 1746 to 1852 and contains the headstone information from three of Athol's graveyards: the "Burial Ground - uptown," the "No. Orange road - 'Old Burial Ground'," and the "'Old Cemetery' (between Pleasant & Spring sts.)"
