Collection description:

Barre, Worcester County, Massachusetts is located near the Ware River eighteen miles northwest of Worcester, Mass., and sixty miles west of Boston. It was settled around 1720 and incorporated in 1774.

This small collection of records from the town of Barre, Mass., includes seven official documents (four deeds, a plan of a farm, a bond, and testamentary of indebtedness), an undated document with the heading "Memorabilia [sic]," and an account prepared for the Barre Gazette of the Democratic celebration of the 4th of July, 1840 (46 p.).
