**COLLECTION DESCRIPTION:**

Benjamin Read (1740?-1806) of Mendon, Mass., held numerous positions in that town, including assessor, constable, selectman, and representative to the General Court. He was also a member of various governmental committees, while serving as a Justice of the Peace for Worcester County.

This volume contains Read's records, for the period 1786 to 1800, of marriages he performed and civil suits, over which he presided.
