<p>Collection Description:</p> <p>This account book of the firm of Boggs and Proudfit of Troy, New York, consists largely of carrier's receipts for goods (generally liquor, salt, tobacco, foodstuffs and army stores) carried from Troy to other dealers, especially in Whitehall, New York. In June 1814 the name of the firm became James Proudfit.</p> <p>There are also general store and miscellaneous account entries for Granville, New York, in the period 1824 to 1828. Many of the entries in this book are covered by newsclippings later pasted into the book.</p>
