Collection description:

Boylston, Worcester County, Massachusetts is located seven miles north-northwest of Worcester, Mass., just east of Wachusett Reservoir. It was settled in 1705 and incorporated in 1786.

This small collection of Boylston, Mass., materials consists of four volumes of lists of residents and non-residents of Boylston, and the assessments levied by the town's tax assessors on real and personal property in the case of residents and real property in the case of non-residents. These assessments were levied for state, county, town, and precinct or parish taxes for the years 1796, 1797, 1803, and 1804. Jothan Bush was the town tax collector charged with collecting the levies listed in each of the volumes.
