COLLECTION DESCRIPTION:

Several Boyntons found in the collection are descendants of settlers who emigrated from Yorkshire, England, to Rowley, Essex County, Mass., in 1638. Two names that frequently recur are Benoni Boynton (1681-1758) and David Atherton Boynton (1800-1876).

This collection is largely comprised of deeds, bonds, petitions, plans, town records, receipts, and various other documents of a legal and financial nature pertaining to the Boynton family. The items mainly concern land transactions and relate to the Massachusetts towns of Rowley, Lunenburg, Groton, Winchendon, Townsend, and the city of Boston. The collection also contains some correspondence and genealogical material.
