<p>Collection description:</p> <p>These volumes of church records of Brimfield, Mass., consist of copies of materials pertaining to the First Congregational Church of that community. The first volume contains copies of church covenants, lists of members, baptisms, and marriages, and documents pertaining to the calling and dismissal of ministers. The second volume contains copies of documents of a committee of citizens, upset with the installation of Clark Brown as minister of the town in 1797. This volume records the continuing controversy over the Rev. Mr. Brown's appointment until his dismissal in 1803.</p>
