<p>Collection description:</p> <p>This volume contains copies of documents pertaining to the incorporation of the Buffumville Manufacturing Company of Oxford, Mass., and its acquisition of title to land and buildings, water rights, and easements. There is also material outlining the history of the ownership, releases, and privileges of the real property owned by the company, as well as articles of incorporation in 1902, company by-laws and minutes of meetings of the company's directors and stockholders from 1903 to 1907. The real property of the company was sold in 1905 to the Pierrepont Mills Corporation and the mortgage on the property was transferred in 1907 to C.N. Prouty of Spencer, Mass.</p>
