<p>Collection description:</p> <p>This collection of papers is mostly comprised of deeds and receipts of the Bullard family. Members of this family lived in Worcester and Middlesex counties in the 17th, 18th and 19th centuries. Names which recur most frequently in the collection are: Benjamin Bullard (1702?-1766), Asa Bullard (1730-1803?), and Artemas Bullard (1768-1842). Massachusetts towns which recur most frequently are: Sherborn, Holliston, Northbridge and Sutton. In addition to the deeds and receipts, there are many bonds, indentures, and miscellaneous legal documents in the collection. The majority of receipts concern Artemas Bullard. There are several papers relating to the settlement of the estates of Benjamin and Asa Bullard. The collection also contains documents pertaining to Artemas Bullard's occupation as treasurer and tax collector of Sutton, Mass, in the 19th century. The collection also includes some letters to Asa and Artemas Bullard as well as several land plans.</p> <p>These papers also contain three account books (1794-1801, 1807-1814, 1814-1843) of Artemas Bullard which concern his medical practice in Northbridge and Sutton as well as his farm in Sutton. There are four day books concerning Artemas Bullard's medical practice in Northbridge and Sutton which cover the period from 1797 to 1806. Also, there are two ledgers (1846-1848, 1848-1850) of Oliver C. Bullard which concern his general store and saw mill in Sutton. See Contents List</p>
