<p>Collection description:</p> <p>This collection of the town records of Chatham, Massachusetts from 1729 to 1843 includes one folder of miscellaneous records and one folio volume of tax records for 1843. The folder contains: receipts for taxes paid by Samuel Godfree from 1729 to 1735; tax lists for the years 1753, 1766, 1787, 1811, 1818, 1819, 1824 and 1843; town accounts (i.e. money for the support of orphans, the poor and sick, and schools) from 1819 to 1830.</p> <p>The tax lists are signed by town assessors and include names, polls, real estate and personal property. Most of the lists are in alphabetical order, and have sections at the end for "Widows" and "Harwich People."</p> <p>The folio volume follows the same format as the other tax lists.</p>
