Collection description:

Christopher Littlefield (1803-1890) was a private school owner and teacher in Kennebunk, Me., town clerk and state representative for Wells, Me., landlord/cashier of the Ocean National Bank in Kennebunk for thirty-four years, and deacon of the Congregational churches in both towns. He also kept the accounts for a general store in Kennebunk, probably located on Garden Street near the old Mousam Mill Pond.

This volume of fifty-four pages contains accounts, purchases, and payments of the store's patrons, many of whom were from well-known families in Kennebunk.
