<p>Collection description:</p> <p>This collection of manuscripts was gathered by George E. Dadmun (-1942) in his effort to write a family genealogy. Primarily, there is correspondence of genealogical interest and reports recording his findings. There is substantial information on the Dadmun family and various lines, including Hooker, Estabrook, Stone, and Davis.</p> <p>There are only a few original manuscripts and photographs, and a watercolor coat of arms, belonging to various members of the family. Included in the Davis family material are two pamphlets, <u>A Sermon on the Death of Hon. John Davis, (1854)</u> and <u>Dolor Davis, a Sketch of His Life, (1881)</u>.</p> <p>One octavo volume is included in this collection. This is a memorial volume dedicated to George A.
