**Collection description:**

Daniel Estabrook (1807-1900) was a shoemaker in Paxton, Mass.

This collection of his papers includes one folder of miscellaneous papers and one account book. The papers, covering the period from 1822 to 1872, include receipts, and many land deeds for tracts of land in Paxton.

The account book, covering the period from 1844 to 1906, includes chronological entries of farm products sold and shoes sold, with long lists of shoes made and repaired for a Lakin and Bigelow, and later R.E. Bigelow & Son. Entries from 1897 to 1906 are made by Daniel's son, George Drury Estabrook (1833- ), and include lists of farm products sold. Two items (an insurance policy, 1846, and a pocket case), have been removed from the collection and filed under "Insurance Policies."
