Collection description:

Dudley, Worcester County, Massachusetts is located seventeen miles south-southwest of Worcester, Mass., near the Connecticut line. It was settled in 1714 and incorporated in 1732.

This collection of town records consists of writs, warrants, summonses, depositions, petitions, claims, indentures, deeds, bonds, certificates, tax lists, account sheets, bills, receipts, official correspondence, and other miscellaneous town records for the period 1740 to 1859. Many of the warrants concern the calling of town meetings and are often accompanied by notifications of compliance to the warrants and by records of the results of the town meetings. Included in the collection is a copy of an address by Anne B. Easterbrooks on "The Old Carter House," 1932.
