COLLECTION DESCRIPTION:

Ebenezer L. Gibbs (ca. 1823-) was probably born in Ashtabula County, Ohio, the son of Calvin Gibbs (1791-) and Jerusha Morgan Gibbs. E.L. Gibbs is listed on the title page of this manuscript as living in Windsor, Ashtabula County, Ohio.

This volume contains Gibbs's calculations for The People's Calendar and Northern Right Almanac (Cleveland: M.C. Younglove & Co., [1848]). The same calculations were used for The Farmer's Western Reserve Almanac, for 1849 (Cleveland: M.C. Younglove & Co., [1848]) and The Farmer's Free Soil Almanac, for 1849 (Ashtabula: George Ray & Co., [1848]). AAS owns all three almanacs. "Herschel's Weather Table" clipped from another almanac is pasted into this volume.
