Collection description:

Edward Augustus Jenks (1830-1908) was born in Newport, N.H., and died in Concord, N.H. He worked as a law reporter, state printer, and writer during the late nineteenth century. In 1889, Jenks received an honorary degree from Dartmouth College.

This volume, attributed to Jenks, is a typescript draft with handwritten corrections containing brief sketches of the judges serving on the New Hampshire Supreme Court and members of the bar who were residents of Concord, N.H. Also, there is a brief history of the New Hampshire Supreme Court from 1771 to 1876.
