Collection description:

Edward Ellington (fl. 1767-1793) published several works including: Christ's Promise to Be Present ... (Savannah, n.d.); The Reproach of Christ ... (London, 1771); and Sermon Preached 25th of March 1771 ... (Savannah, n.d.).

This address by Ellington was apparently delivered to an Episcopal Convention in Charleston, S.C., in 1787. This address discusses the problems of the Episcopalian Church in the U.S. (particularly that of adhering to a liturgy consistent with the Revolution) and proposes the formation of a society within the Church to combat these problems.
