Collection description:

Ellery Vincent Everett (1812-1841), son of Rev. James Everett (1782-1837) and Hannah (Vincent) Everett (1786-1853), was born 25 December 1812, at Dorchester, Mass., and died 23 November 1841, at sea. He was a passenger on the ship Merchant, captained by B. Lombard (-), which left Boston on 29 January 1835 for Calcutta.

This diary is a brief account of that voyage. It is interleaved in the Massachusetts Family Almanac, (Boston: Allen and Co., 1835), and covers the period 29 January-21 December 1835. The diary is a sparse record of stops made and ships passed.
