Etienne Dutilh (-) was a merchant of Philadelphia, Pa.

This collection of papers includes twenty-six bills of lading, 1784-1802, for goods consigned mainly to E. Dutilh & Company and Messrs. E. Dutilh & Wachsmuth. There are also papers, 1793-1805, relating to the seizure by the British of vessels owned by Messrs. E. Dutilh & Wachsmuth and Dutilh and James J. Mazurie. These papers consist mostly of correspondence to Dutilh & Wachsmuth and describe legal actions which followed the capture of their ships.
