Collection description:

Gerry, Worcester County, Massachusetts was a town established in 1786 from parts of Athol and Templeton, Mass. Part of Gerry was annexed to Royalston, Mass., 1799, and Athol, 1806. On 5 February 1814, Gerry changed its name to Phillipston, Mass.

These records written for 1 February 1814 record property valuation for lands in Gerry. Owners of land are listed, size and location of land and improvements are noted and described.
