John Albion Andrew (1818-1867) was a Republican antislavery leader and Unionist, and Governor of Massachusetts from 1860 to 1866.

This small collection of letters includes customary business letters and prefunctory letters dealing with patronage. These manuscripts include a subscription of Worcester community leaders to a fund designed to help Andrew's family after his premature death in 1867.
