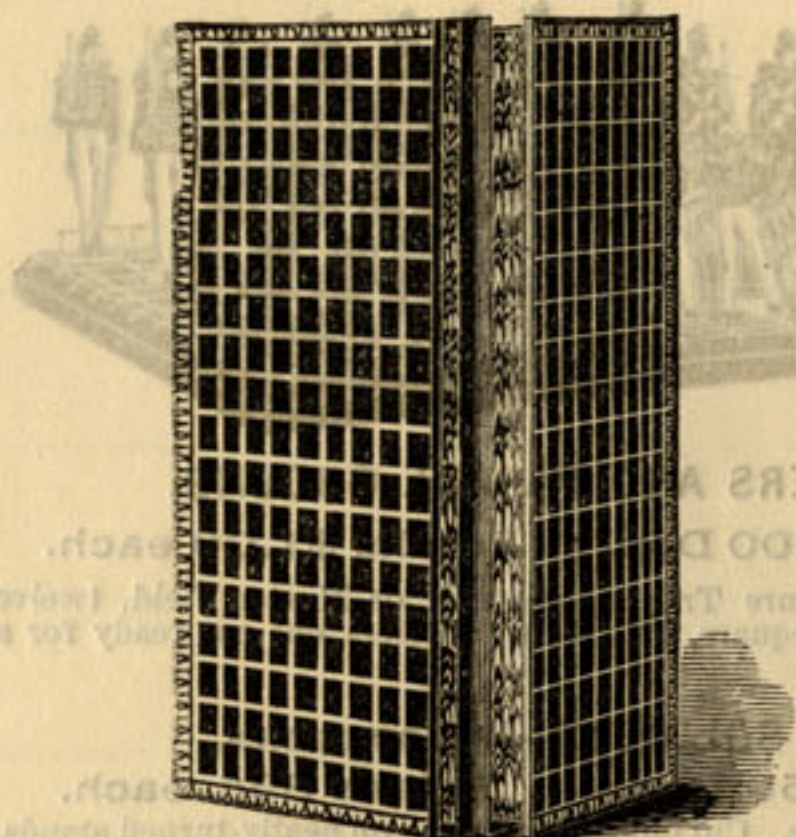


DISSECTED MAP OF THE UNITED STATES

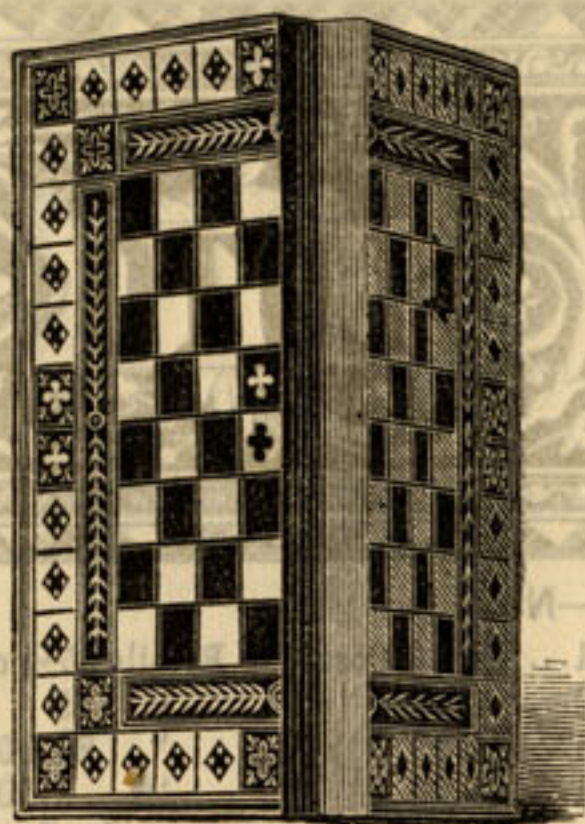
